

The VN-Index experienced a chubby session before riding high late in the afternoon on the back of retail and industrial stocks with reduced liquidity. Foreign investors were net sellers, focusing on Eximbank (EIB, +1.5%), Vinhomes (VHM, -0.92%), and KIDO Group (KDC, +0.16%). Within this past week, liveweight hog prices recorded constant increases reach a new peak of VND 67,000/kg. Many places saw an increase of VND 3,000-5,000 from the previous month to a new high ranging from VND 64,000-67,000/kg. The news helped agriculture stocks like Dabaco (DBC, +1.88%), Hoang Anh Gia Lai (HAG, +0.49%) to gain. Brent crude oil fell 13 cents to USD76.52/barrel yesterday following a 0.5% rise in the previous session. Oil and gas stocks increased PSH (+4.31%), PV Oil (OIL, +1.94%) as a result.



USD/VND & 10-year government bond rates




VN Index sector performance



VN30 futures & VN30 index





Vietnam ETFs - Changes in Fund Total Asset





- TVN closed up 14.52% to VND 7,100/share
- TVN estimates its parent company's pre-tax earnings at VND 133.4 billion in the second quarter of 2023. The figure for 1H23 is more than VND 194 billion, exceeding its full-year target by 273% but down 40% YoY. As shared by the company, the average price of steel-related items fell sharply by 14%-37% from the same period of 2022.


