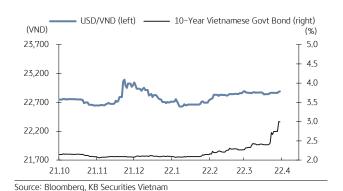

The VN-Index bounced back after three consecutive falling sessions on large-cap stocks recovery after the General Statistics Office reported on the rapid rebound of the local labor market in 1Q22 despite some unsustainability. The Malaysian Ministry of International Trade and Industry (MITI) recently announced that it would suspend licensing for new projects in the paper industry for two years in anticipation of better management and supervision of recovered paper (RCP) imports under new standards. It drove the gains of Dong Hai JSC (DHC, +2.6%), and An Phat Holdings (APH, +2.1%). PV Technical Services (PVS, +3.3%), PV Drilling & Well Services (PVD, +2.9%) rose ahead of news from Reuters that Russia's crude oil production averaged 10.32 million barrels per day (bpd) (-6% MoM) during April 1–11, while OPEC would be unable to replace 7 million bpd of potential Russian oil supply loss and other oil products in the context of imposed sanctions. Foreign investors were net buyers, focusing on Mobileworld (MWG, +2.3%), GELEX Group (GEX, +7%), and Vingroup (VIC, +1.1%).

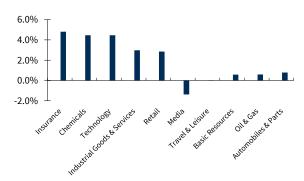
VN Index & HNX Index

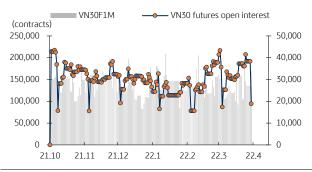

Vietnam ETFs - 3-mth cumulative net buy

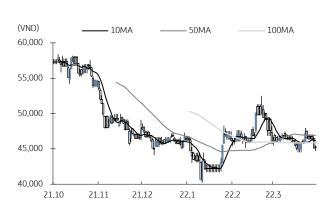

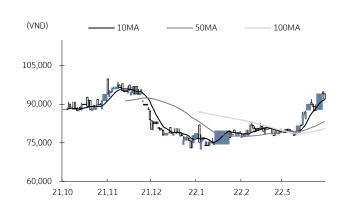

- HPG closed up 0.22% to VND45,200.
- HPG plans to invest about USD4.33 billion in various projects, including an alumina project (2 million tons per year), an ore processing plant (5 million tons per year), an aluminum electrolysis project (0.5 million tons per year), and a wind power plant (1,500 MW).

- MSH closed down -2.23% to VND92,000.
- MSH would pay dividends in 2021 at a rate of 95% vs. 30–45% previously planned, with 45% of cash dividends (advanced) and 50% of share dividends.
- In 2022, MSH aims to achieve VND500 billion (-8% YoY) in PBT on revenue of VND4,900 billion (+3% YoY), planning to pay FY22 dividends at a rate of 15–30%.

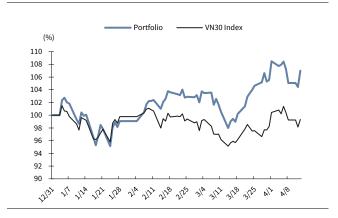
