


Vietnamese and Asian stock markets fell following the Bank of Korea's move to raise interest rates by 0.25 percentage points to a three-year high to curb inflation. The Vietnam Sugar Association (VSSA) expects the domestic sugar prices to benefit from the world sugar prices that are currently at the highest level over the past five years, which sent Quang Ngai Sugar (QNS, +4.4%), Son La Sugar (SLS, +1.5%) higher. Aviation stock Vietnam Airlines (HVN, +0.6%) edged up since the Civil Aviation Authority of Vietnam proposed to the Ministry of Transport to raise domestic fare caps by 3.7% on average compared to the current price bracket. According to DTN, the war in Ukraine has adversely affected the fertilizer market when continuously pushing prices to new peaks, helping PV Ca Mau Fertilizer (DCM, +7%), PV Fertilizer & Chemicals (DPM, +6.2%) to climb. Foreign investors were net sellers, focusing on Hoa Phat Group (HPG, -0.7%), VNDirect (VND, -2.1%), and Vinhomes (VHM, -1.1%).

#### VN Index & HNX Index







## Vietnam ETFs - 3-mth cumulative net buy





- MWG announced the establishment of a subsidiary Bach Hoa
  Xanh Investment and Technology JSC, with a charter capital of
  VND10 billion. The newly established subsidiary will acquire
  Bach Hoa Xanh Trading JSC from MWG, and then make a
  private placement of 20% of shares at maximum, expected
  between 2022 and 2023.

- DGC closed up 6.97% to VND247,200.
- DGC management approved the issuance of more than 200 million shares to pay dividends in 2021 at a rate of 117%, expected in April and May. Accordingly, the charter capital of DGC will increase from VND1,711 billion to VND3,713 billion.


