
Stocks plunged after the International Monetary Fund (IMF) lowered its forecast for global economic growth in FY22–23 by 0.8%/0.2% compared to the previous projections in January due to concerns over the Russia–Ukraine conflict. Along with that, climate change in Europe caused oil prices to drop, pulling oil and gas stocks PV Technical Services (PVS, –9%), PV Drilling & Well Services (PVD, –6.9%) down. Embraer expects Vietnam's aviation industry to grow by 12% annually from 2023, the highest compound annual growth rate in Southeast Asia, and fully recover to its pre–pandemic level in 2023. The positive news helped aviation stocks advance in contrast to the general market, namely Noi Bai Cargo Terminal Service (NCT, +3.6%), Vietnam Airlines (HVN, +1.1%). Foreign investors were net buyers, focusing on GELEX Group (GEX, –6.9%), PV Fertilizer & Chemicals (DPM, –6.8%), and Sacombank (STB, +0.2%).




Futures contracts fell as the IMF slashed its forecast for global economic growth in 2022 and 2023. The basis opened at 14.49 bps then narrowed down to the lowest level of -1.72 bps before closing up to 4.5 bps. Foreign investors were net sellers today, with market liquidity rising sharply.

### Vietnam ETFs - 3-mth cumulative net buy




### Vinh Hoan Corporation (VHC)

- VHC closed up 4.31% to VND106,400.
- VHC targets NPAT of VND1,600 billion (+46% YoY) and revenue of VND13,000 billion (+44% YoY) in FY22 thanks to increased demand, orders, and consumption. The corporation plans to pay dividends in 2021 in cash (20%) and shares (20%). This year, VHC plans to invest VND1,530 billion to expand the aquaculture area and build an animal feed processing plant.

- VIB closed down -2.71% to VND41,350.
- VIB was approved to lift the charter capital by VND5,545 billion to over VND21,000 billion by the State Bank of Vietnam.
   Accordingly, VIB would issue bonus shares to existing shareholders (VND5,436 billion) and employees (0.7% of the charter capital).
