The VNIndex collapsed with larger trading volumes on the selloff seen in real estate, bank and securities. Foreign investors were net sellers, focusing on Vingroup (VIC, -2.4%), Vinhomes (VHM, -5.8%), and Dat Xanh Group (DXG, -6.8%).

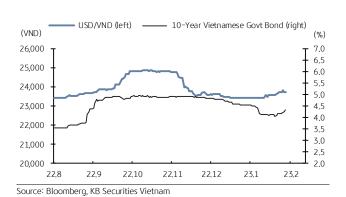
The prices of Vietnam's rice for export maintained its growth momentum in the first two months of 2023, the export price of rice with 5% broken ranked first in the world at times. However, investors kept taking profits due to concerns about the general market, making rice stocks dropped – the PAN Group (PAN, – 0.92%) and Loc Troi Group (LTG, –3.93%).

Oil prices fell on February 21 as persistent concerns about global economic growth led to a selloff. Oil and gas shares like PV Drilling & Well Services (PVD, -4.05%) and PV Technical Services (PVS, -1.52%) also joined the market corrections.

### USD/VND & 10-year government bond rates

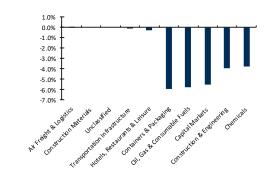


### Vietnam - 3-mth cumulative net foreign buy

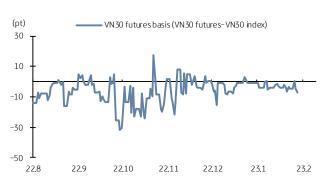


VN30 futures volume & open interest

### Vietnam ETFs - Changes in Fund Total Asset

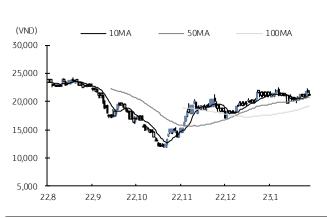

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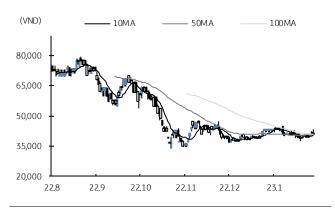

- HPG closed down 1.85% to VND21,200.
- Hoa Phat Group announced its 2023E guidance including NPAT of VND8,000 billion and consolidated revenue of VND150,000 billion, equivalent to a net profit margin of 5.33%.
- In addition, Management also proposed to use the entire VND8,402 billion of the remaining profit for production and business activities, which means the group would not pay cash dividend for 2022.

- DGW closed down 0,72% to VND41,500.
- DGW announced it started to enter the beverage industry with beer products from ABInBev group and completed raising its ownership at Achison, a company specializing in the distribution of labor protection products and industrial equipment, to 60%.

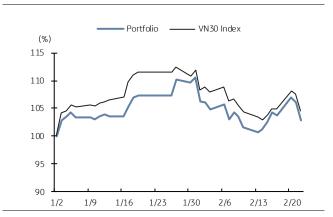
