
VNIndex closed up as the General Department of Customs announced that export turnover hit USD13.2 billion (+3% YoY) in the first half of October 2021. The project to construct Sa Pa Airport in Lao Cai Province was approved with a total investment of nearly VND7,000 billion, which helped Airports Corporation (ACV) to increase. Garment stocks like Nam Dinh Textile Garment (NTD, +8.9%), Century Synthetic Fiber (STK, +5.6%) climbed on the news that export turnover of silk yarns reached 213.4 million (+25% YoY) between October 1–15. Oil prices dropped after the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) forecast a warmer winter in most parts of the US, causing Binh Son Refinery (BSR, -1.7%), Vietnam National Petroleum (PLX, -1.1%) to slightly decrease. Foreign investors were net sellers, focusing on Nam Long Investment (NLG, +6.3%), PAN Group (PAN, -2%), PV Fertilizer & Chemicals (DPM, -1%).



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



### VN30 futures & VN30 index





### VN30 futures volume & open interest





### Vietnam ETFs - 3-mth cumulative net buy




# Hoa Phat Group (HPG)

- HPG closed down 0.87% to VND56,700
- HPG posted its record highest-ever earnings of VND10,350 billion (2.7 times higher than that over the same period) on revenue of VND38,900 billion (+56% YoY) in 3Q21 alone.
- HPG's 9M21 earnings reached VND27,100 billion (+200% YoY) on total revenue of VND105,800 billion (+60% YoY), exceeding the whole year's target by 45%.

- DPM closed down 0.96% to VND46,550
- DPM recorded consolidated earnings of VND759 billion (+246% YoY) on revenue of VND2,824 billion (+44.5%) in 3Q.
   The increase in selling prices and consumption of fertilizers in 3Q contributed to higher profit when compared to the same period last year.
- DPM's urea and NPK fertilizers are currently sold at VND835,000 (2.3 times YTD) and VND665,000 (+43% YTD) per 50kg bag respectively.
