

Vietnam stock market rallied thanks to positive movements of real estate and securities stocks with increased liquidity. Foreign net sell reached VND714.68 billion, concentrated in VPBank (VPB, Unch), Vinhomes (VHM, -0.26%), and Mobileworld (MWG, -2.69%).


Natural gas for December delivery fell 0.17% to USD2.85/mmBTU this morning. Oil and gas stocks like PV Technical Services (PVS, -0.26%) and PV Coating (PVB, -1.35%) also decreased.

Data from the General Department of Customs shows that in the first half of November, Vietnam's fruit and vegetable exports gained 11% YoY to USD187 million. Food industry stocks increased in price – Loc Troi Group (LTG, +4.26%) and the PAN Group (PAN, +0.78%).


VN Index & HNX Index


Futures rose alongside the cash market. The basis opened at 2.8bps and then moved around 0.76bps throughout the session before closing at 2.2bps. Trading volumes decreased.

Foreign investors net sold 795 December futures contracts so far have bought 21,528 contracts. The proprietary trading sector of securities companies net sold 982 contracts and is maintaining a cumulative selling position for 9,949

contracts.



VN30F1M futures volume - Proprietary & foreign trading





Vietnam ETFs - Changes in fund total assets





- CTG closed up 0.68% to VND29,600.
- CTG plans to issue more than 564 million shares to pay dividends (each shareholder owning 1 million shares will receive 117,415 new shares) in early December. If the issuance is successful, the bank's charter capital will increase from VND48,058 billion to VND53,701 billion, still ranked fourth in the Vietnamese banking system.

- BSI closed up 0.11% to VND46,100.
- BSI wants to sell all 505,660 treasury shares to raise working capital for business activities. The transactions should be done in order matching method on the exchange between November 30, 2023 and December 29, 2023. The price is not lower than VND24,391/share. Meanwhile, BSI shares have regained the historical peak of over VND46,000/share set in November 2021.


