

Banks led the VNIndex rallies with reduced liquidity. Foreign investors were net buyers, focusing on Hoa Phat Group (HPG, Unch), Vincom Retail (VRE, +2.1%), and SSI Securities (SSI, +0.4%).


Vietnam's fisheries exports to the UK market in June reached 4,400 tons, equivalent to USD29 million (up 22% in volume and 16% in value compared to June 2022). This is also the best result recorded in this export market in the first half of 2023, which boosted fisheries stocks like Nam Viet Corp (ANV, +0.53%) and Cuu Long Fish (ACL, +1.79%).

Given declining orders and unit prices, the textile and garment industry lowered its export target by 17% compared to the positive case built at the beginning of the year and down by 10% YoY to USD39–40 billion. Century Synthetic Fiber (STK, -2.82%) and Song Hong Garment (MSH, -0.53%) fell.

VN Index & HNX Index




USD/VND & 10-year government bond rates





VN30 futures & VN30 index



Vietnam ETFs - Changes in Fund Total Asset





- VJC management passed a plan to issue VND2,000 billion in corporate bonds. The capital mobilized should be used to pay operating expenses on fuel, port, flight management, engineering, salary, insurance, aircraft pre-delivery payment and other expenses.

- TCB closed up 3.24% to VND33,500.
- TCB 2Q23 pre-tax earnings reached VND5,649 billion (-23% YoY) with VND9,325 billion (-15% YoY) in total operating income. In 1H23, the bank reached pre-tax profit decreased 20% YoY to VND11,272 billion.


