

Vietnam stock market rallied at the end of the session, similar to the movements of the global stock market after JPMorgan's representative said the supply shortage showed signs of improvement. According to the Vietnam Sugarcane and Sugar Association, the harvested area of sugarcane in this crop year is 148,196 hectares, bringing in 8.6 million tons of sugarcane (down 10% YoY), which is equivalent to a yield of 66.5 tons per hectare (up 6% YoY). This boosted sugar stocks like Thanh Thanh Cong – Bien Hoa (SBT, +2.9%) and Quang Ngai Sugar (QNS, +2%). Rising production and export costs pushed shrimp prices up again in Ecuador, making this country's shrimp industry less competitive and benefiting Vietnamese fishery shares like Sao Ta Foods (FMC, +4.2%). Liveweight hog prices rebounded on the news the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development forecast liveweight hog and chicken prices would be higher in the next two weeks, raising livestock company Dabaco (DBC, +4.1%). Foreign net sell focused on Nam Long Group (NLG, +1.3%), Vinamilk (VNM, -0.6%) and Vincom Retail (VRE, +0.7%).


VN Index & HNX Index



VN30 futures & VN30 index




VN30 futures volume & open interest

Front month VN30 futures basis







- MBB closed up 1.3% to VND27,950.
- MBB recorded a 3Q consolidated profit of VND3,898 billion (+29% YoY) and provision expense of more than VND1,778 billion (doubling the expense in 3Q20).
- As of September 30, customer loans rose 13% to VND336,426 billion, bad debt ratio decreased from 1.09% to 0.95%, and loan loss coverage ratio improved from 102% to 150%.

- GAS closed up 1.6% to VND113,800
- GAS's 3Q earnings and revenue were VND2,464 billion (+19% YoY) and VND18,543 billion (+16%YoY) respectively.
- The enterprise said that gas consumption and liquefied petroleum gas output declined 26% YoY and 10% YoY respectively. However, the average Brent oil price gained 71% YoY or USD30.6 per barrel, which helped to improve GAS business performance.
