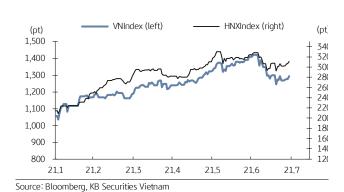

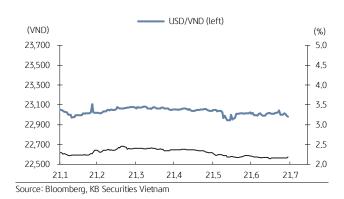

The VN-Index was firmer like other Asian indices amid optimistic sentiment supported by the news Fed would keep interest rates at 0% and not cut asset purchases with the assumption that the US economy would continue to rebound. Reuters noted Vietnamese rice export prices fell to the lowest since March 2020 as the supply outweighed the demand, which triggered losses in Loc Troi Group (LTG, -1%) and An Giang Import-Export (AGM, -0.7%). Industrial parks like Sonadezi (SZL, +1.8%) and Kinh Bac City Development (KBC, +0.6%) closed up after the Vietnam Association of Real Estate Brokers assessed there is a booming demand in the industrial real estate market in Long An, Dong Nai, Binh Duong, Binh Dinh, Thanh Hoa, Quang Ninh, Hai Duong, and Bac Giang. Fertilizer company Phu My Fertilizer (DPM, +4.3%) posted strong 2Q performance thanks to higher fertilizer prices. Foreigners netsold, focusing on Hoa Phat Group (HPG, +0.9%), the Diamond ETF (FUEVFVND, +1.6%) and Vincom Retail (VRE, +0.6%).

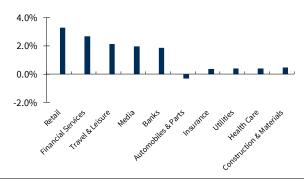
VN Index & HNX Index



USD/VND & 10-year government bond rates

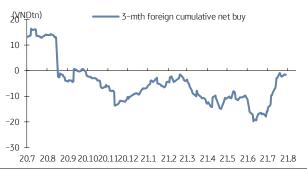


VN Index sector performance

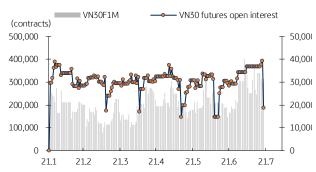

Vietnam ETFs - 3-mth cumulative net buy

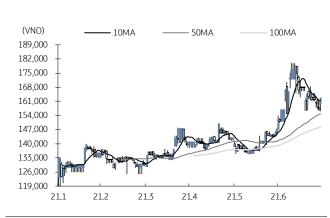

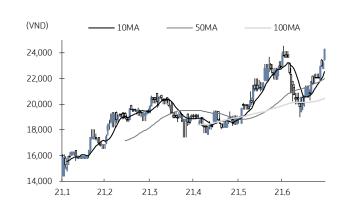

- MWG closed up 3.6% to VND162,800
- MWG disclosed 1H21 earnings are VND2,551 billion (+26% YoY) on revenue of VND62,487 billion (+12.3% YoY).
- In the revenue structure, Dien May Xanh, The Gioi Di Dong, and Bach Hoa Xanh store chains accounted for 53.3% (+5% YoY), 25% (+7% YoY), and 21, 4% (+42% YoY) respectively.

- DPM closed up 4.3% to VND24,300
- DPM announced 2Q earnings at VND684 billion (+126% YoY) on revenue of VND2,931 billion (+34% YoY).
- Strong performance was attributable to the increase in fertilizer prices compared to the same period last year, and the adjustment of the journal entries at the request of the State Audit.

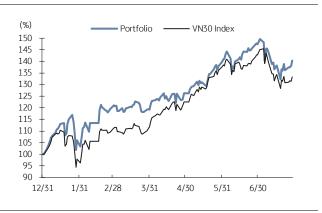
