



Banks helped the VNIndex regain some points dropped from the last plunges. Vietinbank (CTG, +3.9%), Tecombank (TCB, +2.2%), and Prosperity Bank (VPB, +4.1%) bounced back after the State Bank approved to increase credit growth limit. China Customs Administration (GACC) rejected seafood imports from eight Indian exporters from one to nine weeks, which cheered Vietnam fishery companies that own a big market share in China like Nam Viet Corp (ANV, +5.1%) and Vinh Hoan Corp (VHC, +2.8%). PV Gas (GAS, -0.9%) lagged due to lower oil prices as Saudi Arabia and the UAE reached an output raising deal. Foreign investors were net buyers, focusing on Hoa Phat Group (HPG, +3.3%), SSI Securities (SSI, +5.3%) and Sacombank (STB, +5.1%).


VN Index & HNX Index



USD/VND & 10-year government bond rates




VN Index sector performance

Futures rallied at the end of the session, following the positive movements of the underlying market. The basis opened at -1.3bps, and dropped sharply to -5.9bps before rebounding to the intraday peak of 10bps. It moved sideways and closed at 1.5 in the afternoon. Foreigners traded in balance today with lighter trading volumes.



VN30 futures & VN30 index





Vietnam ETFs - 3-mth cumulative net buy




Vietnam Prosperity Bank (VPB)

- VPB closed up 4.1% to VND64,000
- VPB's 1H21 revenue is VND23,100 billion (+22.5% YoY), of which net interest income, net profit from service activities, and net profit from investment securities post respective gains of 16.7% YoY, 50% YoY and 160% YoY.
- Two strategic segments, retail banking and SMEs, have the biggest credit growth (17% and 21% respectively).

- PPC closed up 0.6% to VND23,500
- PPC published 2Q results with VND120 billion (-57% YoY) in earnings on revenue of VND1,218 billion (-46% YoY). Subdued performance was due to a decrease in sold power output (down 47% YoY to 902 million kWh).
- The company's profit mostly comes from financial income of VND220 billion.
